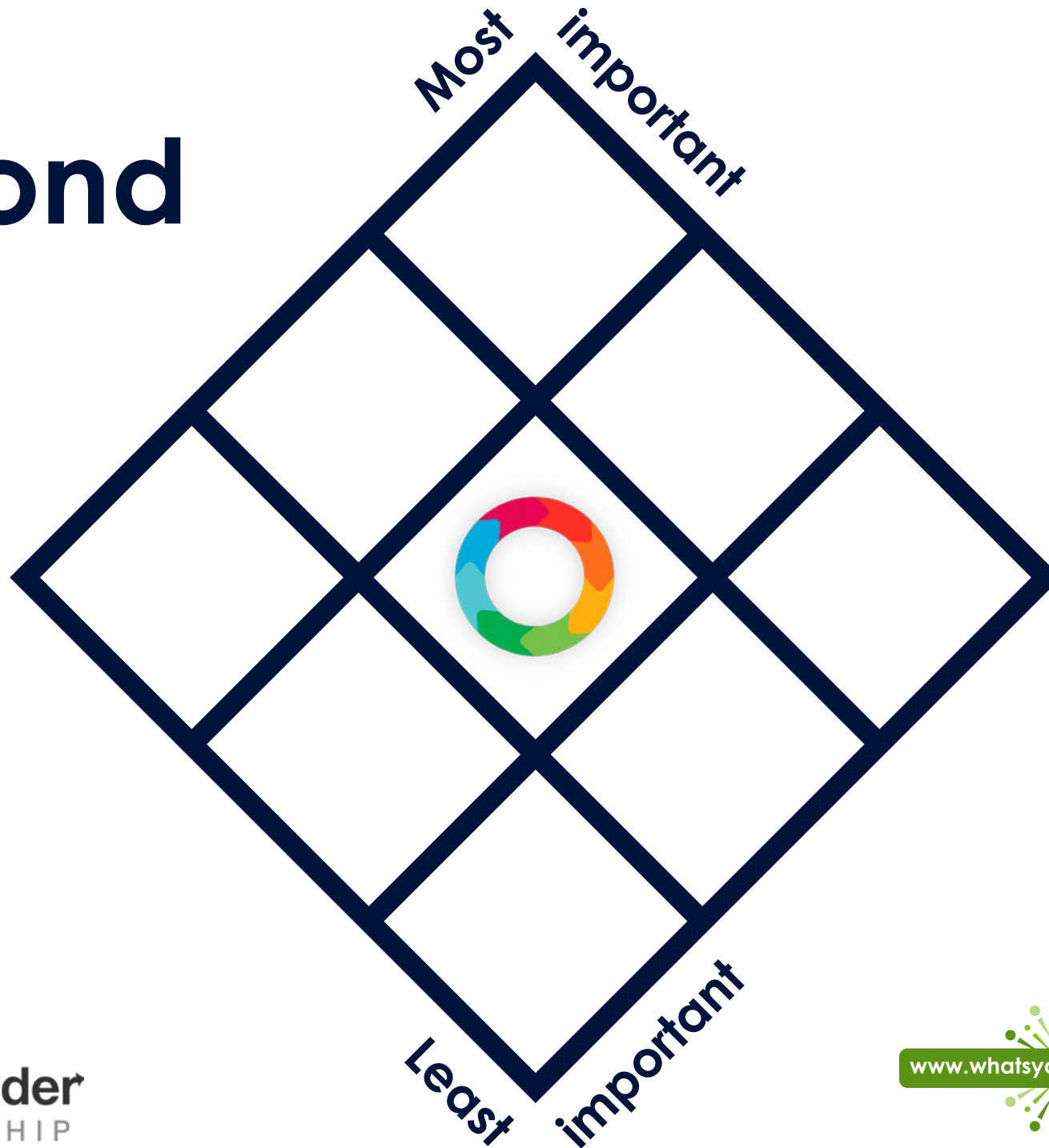


Skills Diamond



How to use your Skills Diamond

1. Cut out the small 8 diamonds
2. In pairs you are going to discuss which skills are most important to different jobs. You could talk about a job you already know or find a new one to explore by using one of the websites below.
3. After you have read or watched the information, discuss which skills would be most important for that job.
4. Using your 8 small diamonds, rank the skills from most to least important on your Skills Diamond worksheet.
5. There is no right or wrong with this activity. The most important thing is to be able to explain your reasons and give examples of how the skills are important for the job you have chosen.
